(Concord Hospital and Concord Regional VNA) offers supportive care for people who are seriously ill. We focus on providing relief from symptoms and stress of a serious illness. Our goal is to improve quality of life for you and your loved ones.

Palliative care is provided by a team of doctors, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, social workers, and chaplains. We work with your primary care provider and your other doctors to provide an extra layer of support. You can ask for a visit with us at any age and at any stage of a serious illness, and this support is provided even if you are getting treatment.

Palliative care includes:

- Expert symptom management in treating pain, fatigue, constipation, breathing problems, nausea, anxiety, and depression
- Advance care planning including help with making difficult decisions
- Emotional, spiritual, and community-based support
- Visits at your provider's office, in nursing homes, at your home, and at Concord Hospital
